1. Must complete a special Workforce Continuing Education Cosmetology Program application.
2. High school diploma, official transcript or High School Equivalency Program (formerly GED)
3. Must register for the Career Readiness Certificate (CRC*), and must score a Bronze level to qualify for admission.

**The Career Readiness Certificate is a portable credential that demonstrates achievement and a certain level of workplace employability skills in applied mathematics, locating information, and reading for Information.*
