### **Prerequisites**

- Must complete a special Workforce Continuing Education Cosmetology Program application.
- High school diploma, official transcript or High School Equivalency Program (formerly GED)
- Must register for the Career Readiness Certificate (CRC\*), and must score a Bronze level to qualify for admission.

\*The Career Readiness Certificate is a portable credential that demonstrates achievement and a certain level of workplace employability skills in applied mathematics, locating information, and reading for Information.
